- d. Is it possible the public voice of the Board does not reflect the private intent. Sovereign FBO still appears possible.

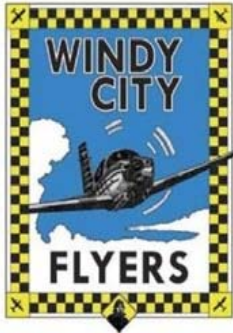

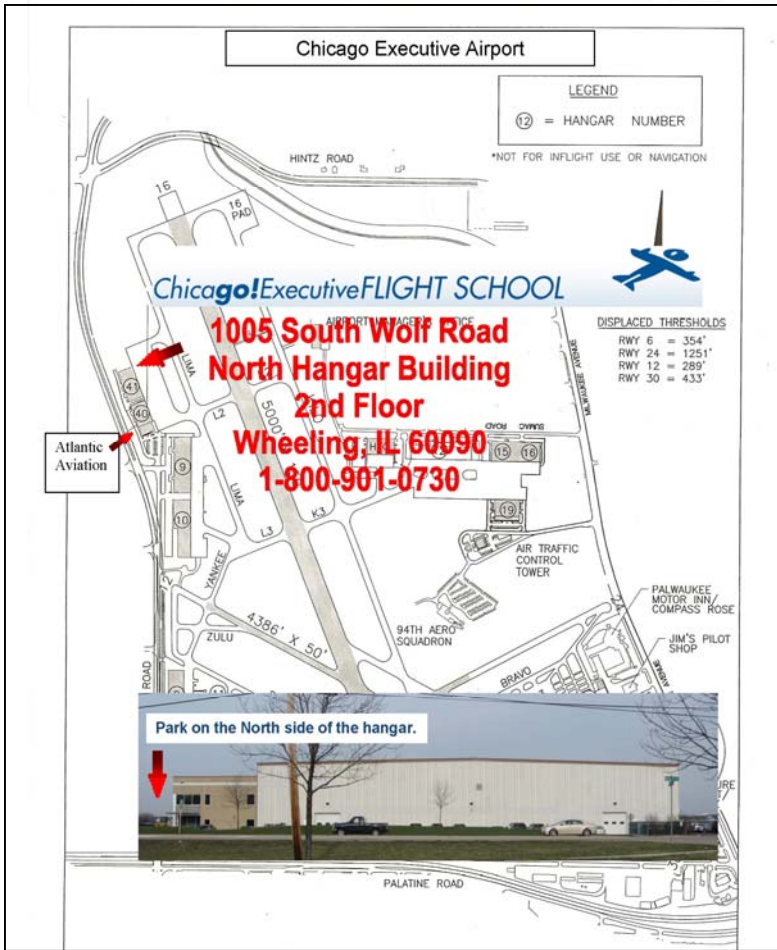

### Note from Our Airport Manager's Office:

.....a reminder about the taxi-route coming into and out of the t-hangar complex. The flow should be in to the t-hangars on taxiway Quebec, and out to the airfield on taxiway Papa. I've attached a map/graphic. Taxiway Quebec is open for aircraft taxi.

Also, the Tower has informed us that they have a hard time seeing aircraft who call from the front of their hangar units. They ask that aircraft taxi down taxiway Papa and stop at the taxiway Kilo/ILS hold-short marking on taxiway Papa, then call Tower to make your initial call for taxi instructions. Again, I've attached a map/graphic and a picture.

As you have heard, the Pilot's Lounge in building 52 is almost ready for use. One more inspection on the sewer system and some final paperwork and we should be ready to occupy. This also goes for the bathrooms in buildings 54, and 56. As soon as everything comes online we'll let you know.

### Landing with a Porpoise.

Notice Number: NOTC2675

When a bounced landing is improperly recovered, the airplane may land nose first -- setting off a series of motions that imitate the jumps and dives of a porpoise. This problem is usually from improper airplane attitude at touchdown.

The corrective action for a porpoise is the same as for a bounce and depends on the severity of the oscillations. When it is very slight and there is no large change in the airplane's pitch attitude, a follow-up landing may be executed by applying sufficient power to cushion the subsequent touchdown, and smoothly adjusting the pitch to the proper touchdown attitude.

When a porpoise is severe, the safest procedure is to EXECUTE A GO-AROUND IMMEDIATELY. In a severe porpoise, the airplane's pitch oscillations can become progressively worse, until the airplane strikes the runway nose first with sufficient force to collapse the nose gear.
