Enjoy a local author's work covering our aviation history!



Biweekly FAA Safety Briefing News Update

FAA Completes Final ADS-B Milestone

The FAA completed its final implementation milestone with ADS-B, the state-of-the-art surveillance system that enables air traffic controllers to track aircraft with greater accuracy and reliability. The last two of the 155 airports to receive ADS-B, Akron-Canton Airport and Mansfield Lahm Regional Airport, both in Ohio, became operational last month. This brings the operational rollout of ADS-B baseline services to a successful conclusion, on schedule and within budget, well in advance of Jan. 1, 2020, the date by which aircraft flying in certain, controlled airspace must be equipped with the technology.

ADS-B is now operational at air traffic control facilities across the country. These include airports, Terminal Radar Approach Control Facilities, and en route facilities. All are using ADS-B as the preferred source of surveillance, which provides improved situational awareness to both pilots and controllers, among many other benefits and improvements.
